NOTICE OF RACE

The Organizing Authority is the New Plymouth Yacht Club.

1 Rules

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2 The Yachting New Zealand Safety Regulations Part 1 and Part 5 [Category C] shall apply.

2 Changes to Racing Rules

- 2.1 The Racing Rules will be changed in accordance with rule 86 as follows:
- 2.2 Rule 61.1 (a) will be altered. All classes entered in this regatta will not be exempt from displaying a protest flag.

3 Changes to Class Rules

3.1 Refer NPYC sailing instructions

4 Eligibility and Entry

- 4.1 The regatta is open to Lasers, 420's, Paper Tigers, Starlings and Optimists that comply with Class Rules. If there are insufficient entries to make up a class (3 min), yachts will be grouped into Open Classes.
- 4.2 Entries will be accepted until 13:00 hrs, 28th March 2024 by completing the entry form at <u>www.npyc.co.nz</u> / events.
- 4.3 To be eligible to compete in this event each competitor shall be a financial member of a club recognized by Yachting New Zealand and attend a school in the Taranaki Region.

5 Schedule of Events

Registration 28th March 2024 between 1200 to 1300 hours at New Plymouth Yacht Club.

5.2 Briefing: 28th March 2024 at 1300 hrs at New Plymouth Yacht Club.

5.3 Racing Schedule:

Race 1 First warning signal 1357 hrs

Followed by races 2 and 3, held back to back.

6 Prize giving

6.1 Prize giving will be held as soon as possible after completion of racing.

7 Sailing Instructions

7.1 The NPYC Sailing Instructions will apply. Additional copies will be available for visitors at registration.

8 Racing Area

8.1 The races will be held in the vicinity of Port Taranaki.

9 **Courses to be sailed**

9.1 The courses may be windward leeward or triangle windward/leeward or a combination thereof.

10 Scoring

10.1 The low-points scoring system of Appendix A will apply.

11 Alternative Penalties

11.1 Refer NPYC sailing instructions

12 Prizes

12.1 1st, 2nd and 3rd prizes will be awarded in each class, dependent on entries.

13 Team Support Boats

- 13.1 Team Support boats will be allowed.
- 13.2 Support boats must be registered with the Organizing Authority at registration (clause 5.1 above).

14 Launching

14.1 All dinghy's must be launched and retrieved from the beach in front of the New Plymouth Yacht Club.
